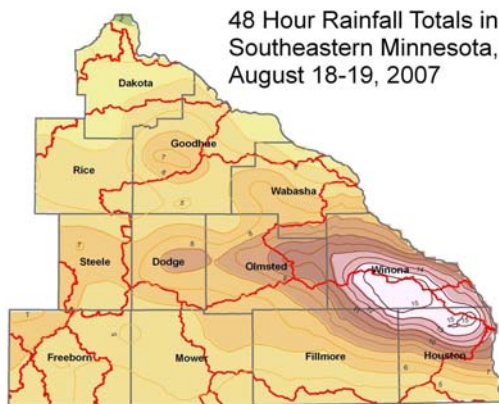


# Understanding the August 2007 Flood: Implications for Natural Resource Management
