

Graduate Studies Criteria for DOCTORAL FACULTY STATUS Winona State University

1. Faculty wishing to be designated as **Core or Associate Doctoral Faculty** must:
- a) be approved by the graduate council according to the requirements listed in the table below.
 - b) have their appointment status re-evaluated every 5 years from the date of approval.

Qualifications for Core Doctoral Faculty

1. *Education*: doctoral degree or appropriate experience;
2. *Scholarly and research attainments*: evidence of mature, independent work continuing to the present in scholarly, research, or creative activities. Such evidence takes the form of published books, scholarly monographs, articles or other appropriate refereed journals, presentations, consultantships, or other significantly scholarly and professional activity;
