

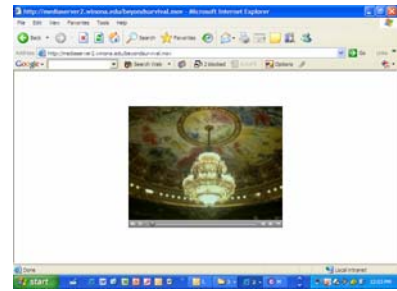
How to view streamed video programs

On your laptop:

1. Go to WSU streamed video web site:

http://www.winona.edu/its/mediaservices/videos/digital_video_collection.htm

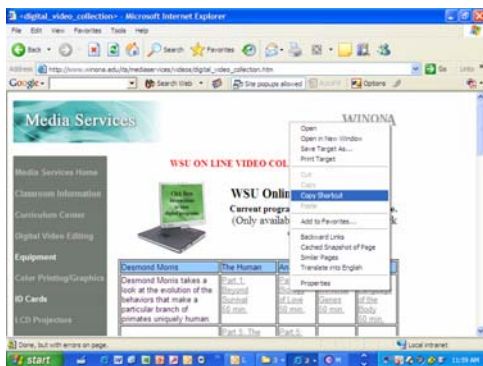
2. Select your program by clicking on any of the titles
3. This allows you to view the program through your internet browser.
4. Note: the video image cannot be resized.



To show video in class:

1. Connect your laptop to LCD projection system in classroom
2. Connect to campus network.
3. Go to WSU streamed video web site:

http://www.winona.edu/its/mediaservices/videos/digital_video_collection.htm



4. Right click on title you wish to show to your class
5. Select: save target as quicktime mov file to your desktop, so it can easily be deleted when you are finished.
6. This can be done in advance.
7. Note: You can only play this video when connected to the campus network. We strongly recommend that you do not use the wireless network because these files are too large.

8. To start video double click on video_title icon



9. Your video image can be resized by clicking and dragging the lower corner of quicktime viewer to fill the screen.
10. You can easily move to any section of the program just by moving the timeline indicator

11. If video does not appear on quicktime video screen then you need to update your version of Quicktime. To do this, go to Start menu, then programs, then accessories, then Quicktime, Click on "Quicktime updater."
