

Winona State to add four to Athletic Hall of Fame



Winona State University will add four new members to its Athletic Hall of Fame this weekend. Four members who made an impact at WSU, and beyond - including the professional wrestling ring - upon their graduation.

Daniel Malm, Brian Paulson, Stephanie Bitter and **Charles Zane, Jr.**, will each be inducted into an elite group of former athletes and coaches.

A reception will be held at 6 p.m. today in Tau Center, followed by a recognition dinner at 7 p.m. Registration, which is required, can be done by calling the Alumni Office at (507) 457-5027, or by going online at www.alumni.winona.edu. Cost is \$20.

In order to be eligible for the WSU Athletic Hall of Fame, which was created in 1985, a player must be a WSU graduate, a letter winner, or a former coach or faculty member.

In addition, there must be a 10-year period between the athlete's or coaches last participation.
