

Retiree Center Steering Committee – Term Limits Proposal

Membership:

Membership is open to all retirees of Winona State University and current employees that fill the requirements of the committee charge set by WSU.

Membership is available on a term basis and commences with August of each academic year.

Membership to the WSU Retiree Center will be two-year renewable term in one representation. A member may serve on the Steering Committee no more than eight consecutive years. When a member has served eight consecutive years, a two-year hiatus before becoming eligible to assume another Steering Committee representation will be taken.

Active membership in the Retiree Center Steering Committee entails participation in meetings, resource groups and sponsored events.

A Steering Committee member may give intent to resign at any time by giving written notice to the Director of the Retiree Center.

Executive Board of the Steering Committee will serve as counsel to the Director for immediate issues. The Executive Board of the Steering Committee will consist of current Chairperson, current Vice Chairperson and the Past Chairperson.

The chair (and/or vice-chair) shall preside over all meetings of the WSU Retiree Center Steering Committee. The Chair will develop agendas for committee meetings with the WSU Retiree Center Director.

Members of the Steering Committee will take an active role in resource groups for the Retiree Center: Assessment & Evaluation, Newsletter, Website, Social, Senior University, Student Learning Resource, Speaker's Bureau, Computer Resource and other outreach groups as they are identified.
