Course description change

## PROPOSED revision to BUSA 321 course description.

This course examines ethics within the corporate environment and provides students with a conceptual framework with which to analyze and make ethical decisions. Topics addressed in this course include, but are not limited to, stakeholder relationships, social responsibility, corporate governance, organizational relationships, ethical business cultures, corporate ethics programs and business ethics in the global economy.

## **CURRENT BUSA 321 course description.**

This course examines ethics within an organization and the pressures derived from societal and governmental expectations. Students will review and critique legislation and judicial opinions addressing the entire continuum of organizational activities through the use of case studies.
