WINONA STATE UNIVERSITY NOTIFICATION OF BANKING OF A COURSE OR PROGRAM

Winona State University Regulation 3-19 states that a department may bank an inactive course or program and no longer list it in the catalog by providing a written request to that department's dean with a rationale for this action. Upon the Dean's approval, the Academic Affairs and Curriculum Committee and the Academic Vice President will be notified. A course or approgram which has been banked cannot be reinstated except by following the procedure outlined in Regulation 3-19. Any program which is banked and not reinstated within five years should be permanently deleted.
