- Resume
- Narrative
 - Applicants should submit a statement answering the following questions:
 - Introduce yourself to the selection committee.
 - Why do you wish to become an Athletic Trainer and why do you feel you would be a successful applicant?
 - Why Winona State University?
 - What are your career goals?
 - Narrative should be no more than 3 pages in length
- Copy of Unofficial Transcripts from all College/University attended. Note: Official transcripts will be required for the WSU School of Graduate Studies
- 50 Athletic Training observational hours – documentation from supervising ATC
- Three – Letters of Recommendation
- Current CPR/AED Certification – Acceptable Certifications
 - BLS for the Healthcare Provider – American Heart Association
 - BLS for Healthcare Providers or CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer – American Red Cross
- TOEFL Score (for International Students only)

- Application Fee – a \$20 application fee is required

- Primary Application Process – November 1st
- Secondary Application Process – May 15th. NOTE: Rolling admission occurs following Primary Application Process until cohort is filled. Submission of application early is recommended.
