Gen Ed Goals 1 - 10 require a minimum of 40 total credits, even if students use Double Listed courses to meet more than one category. Students typically apply for admission to the program in semester 3 and start the professional education sequence in semester 4. <u>Once admitted in Semester 4, students are expected to follow the outlined course sequence below unless otherwise advised by an assigned advisor.</u> Therefore, students need to complete most if not all Gen Ed requirements before semester 4 to avoid scheduling conflicts with teacher licensing coursework in the remaining semesters.
