LARGE UPDATE: In the past week, it has come to my attention that SE Tech has decided to charge for the use of the rugby fields (which we built) on their campus. They will be charging \$3500 per team or \$7000 total. This is a *very* large portion of what they receive from sports club council on a yearly basis. It will be very difficult to raise that money year in and year out for each club. We would really appreciate the extra budget to help cover this for our teams here on campus, especially when hit with an unexpected fee like this. It would greatly impact the future of these clubs if they had to continue to pay this on a yearly basis.

Sports Club Council funds provide competitive collegiate sports teams that are not recognized Winona State University Athletics teams with annual foundational budgets. Teams spend these funds from Winona State University accounts with great help from Melissa Soppa, the WSU Business Office, and Rachel Cromheecke in WSU Legal Affairs using WSU and MnSCU acquisition forms signed by their club advisors who are all employees of Winona State University.

Funds are also needed to support the foundation for risk management with the Sport Club Council program.

This last year we've restructured our tier system, how funds are allocated, and had monthly meetings to discuss various sports club information. Teams have also been utilizing their funds completely but also have been using fundraising opportunities quite frequently to boost their reserves.

Each sports club utilizes their funding in various ways. Most typically and recently, it has been new uniforms and travel expenses related to national and local trips where our various clubs compete. The risk management budget continues to be a large asset for clubs sports as we know that we have something to fall back on in case of emergencies, which have happened in years past.
