



Isolation and Quarantine Recommendations

If You Test POSITIVE for COVID-19 (regardless of vaccination status)





Stay home



If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving, you can leave your house. Continue to wear a mask around others If You were EXPOSED to COVID-19 & are Boosted



Test on Day 5 or if you develop symptoms



Wear a mask around others for 10 days If You were EXPOSED to COVID-19 & Unvaccinated OR Vaccinated >6 mo. ago with Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or >2 mo. ago with J&J vaccine





Winter Safe Activities - Wellness




Flu Shots

- Reserve saved us to a degree
- Counselor consuming a portion of our fee (\$18) (13.9% increase FY19)
- Asking for 1.5% increase in fees
