

## Canvassing Policy for WSU Residence Halls

The following policy covers all residence halls for students owned and/or leased by Winona State University.

Canvassing: All Political Candidates, all people seeking support for a petition, and all people campaigning to gain support for a referendum shall:

1. [Notify](#) the Residence Housing Association (RHA) Executive President at least one (1) week in advance of requested canvassing date(s).
2. All canvassing (door knocking) shall be done between the hours of 5pm-8pm.
3. All candidates and/or representatives and petitioners must check in at the front desk of the appropriate residence hall.
4. All candidates and/or representatives agree to wear identification i.e. nametag, t-shirt/hat of candidate, etc.
5. All candidates and/or representatives and petitioners must skip any door with a sign indicating they do not want to be canvassed.
6. There shall be no materials placed on the door and/or slid underneath any doors.
7. Candidates and/or representatives and petitioners may set up information tables in designated areas, with the approval of the Hall Director.
8. Any request shall fall under the guidelines outlined by Minnesota State Law.

Any candidate and/or representative and petitioner violating these policies are subject to removal from the building by WSU Campus Security and Residence Life Staff.
