4. KEAP Council Member

Give a summary of what you did as a KEAP Council Member including projects you worked on or other activities.

5. Inclusion and Diversity Committee Member for Student Senate

Give a summary about what you did as a representative of the Inclusion and Diversity committee member on the Student Senate and your experience on this committee.

6. Attend a Conference or Retreat

Give a summary of what conference or retreat you attended including speaker presentations, workshops you attended, and what you learned from the overall experience.

7. Minimum of 20 Volunteer Hours

Give a summary of what you did as a volunteer.

8. Recipient of Inclusion and Diversity Scholarship

Give a summary about what you did to receive and keep the scholarship.
