Pay Application Fee \$ 20 (pay online with credit card, with personal check or money order, payable to Winona State University) 3. Submit Official transcripts 4. Send English Language Proficiency Exam Scores <i>*WSU school code for TOEFL is 6680. ACT school code is 2162.</i> 5. Send an original bank statement with a minimum of US \$23,000 balance. 6. Indicate the relationship, financial commitment, and willingness to sponsor the applicant. This letter is not required if financial documents are in the applications name. 7. Send a copy of your passport or birth certificate
