Argentina

❖ [Sol Education Abroad in Argentina: Study Abroad & Spanish Immersion](#)

Learn at the esteemed University of Belgrano in the bustling city of Buenos Aires. With the unique Argentine accent, you will learn how to speak Spanish anywhere! Some courses available here include Beginner Spanish, Intermediate Spanish I/II, Advanced Spanish I/II and more.

Chile
