Asia

China

- ❖ [University of Hong Kong \(Exchange\)](#) - The University of Hong Kong is the territory's oldest institute of higher learning and an internationally recognized, research led, comprehensive university. Some of the courses available here will include Human Rights in Practice, Intellectual Property and Conflict of Laws, Language and the Law, and many others.

South Korea

- ❖ [Chung-Ang University \(Exchange\)](#) - Established in 1918, CAU has taken a leading role in nurturing intellectuals of the nation. Chung-Ang is fully committed to helping Korean and international students realize their life goals and achieve their greatest potential. Some of the courses available here include English Legal Writing and Research and Introduction to the American Law.

Australia/ Pacific Islands

- ❖ [IFSA-Butler Engage Australia](#) - IFSA-Butler's Engage programs are high quality, affordable study abroad opportunities for the career-driven student. Program tracks make it easy to find and select courses, and students can mix and match courses from different tracks for maximum academic flexibility. Some of the courses available here include Understanding Criminology; Crime, Control and Criminal Justice, Contemporary Issues in Criminology and many others.
- ❖ [Southern Cross University](#)- Southern Cross University is a vibrant, contemporary Australian University located in Lismore and very close to the beach. There are many criminal justice courses available at this university, some of them including Legal Research and Writing, Principles of Equity, Administrative Law and many more.

Europe

Denmark

- ❖ [DIS – Study Child Development & Diversity in Copenhagen, Denmark](#) – Enrich and develop your critical thinking skills through investigating and reflecting on current issues in child development and education. Some courses include Humanitarian Law and Armed Conflict and Economics of Crime.

- ❖ [DIS – Study Psychology in Copenhagen, Denmark](#) – This program focuses on psychological theory, research, and practice, with an emphasis on its application in a Danish and European context. Some of the courses available here include Humanitarian Law, Armed Conflict and Economics of Crime, and Gender Perspectives on Human Rights.

England

- ❖ [CIS Abroad Semester at University of Westminster](#) - On Semester at Westminster, you can study in London, taking classes for your major or as electives at an internationally recognized institution while exploring this lively, diverse city. There are multiple criminal justice courses available here, some of them including Justice and Human Rights, Researching Crime and Justice, Victims of Crime and many others.
- ❖ [Lancaster University](#) - Lancaster is home to almost 3000 international students. A beautiful city with access to city, coast and countryside. The very best of British. Some of the courses available here include Introduction to Criminology and Criminal Justice, Contemporary Issues, Criminal Careers, Crimes of Power and many others.
- ❖ [UW-Platteville Education Abroad at St Mary's University Twickenham, London](#) - Founded in 1850, St Mary's is the only Catholic university in London and the largest in the UK. Ireland

There are many Law and Government courses available here, some of them including Introduction to Law, Criminal Law, Contemporary Law and many more.

Some of the courses offered here include Criminology, Crime in Society and others.

Italy

- ❖ [SAI Programs - John Cabot University](#) - JCU is an American university located in the historic Trastevere section of Rome; from this vantage, the splendors of the city are within walking distance. Some possible courses include General Psychology, Social Psychology, and Intro to Sociology.

Scotland

- ❖ [CISabroad Semester in Edinburgh](#) - Edinburgh Napier University is rapidly becoming the most modern and advanced university in Scotland. Spain

- ❖ [Barcelona SAE Universidad Autonoma de Barcelona \(UAB\) - International Business and Humanities Program Semester](#) - The International Business and Humanities Program Semester based at the Universidad Autónoma de Barcelona (UAB) is specially designed for students from around the world who do not have upper-level Spanish skills

but can benefit by learning the language in addition to taking courses in the Social Sciences, Humanities and Economics in English.

North America

- ❖ [HECUA Race in America: Then & Now](#) - Race in America: Then and Now dives into questions of racial justice in America today, and the continuing role of race in the United States. Students meet with civil rights activists who were active in the 1960s, and those who are active now, as well as lawyers, politicians, educators and youth. This consists of one 6 credit course called Race In America: Then & Now.

South America

- ❖ [CISabroad Semester in Ecuador \(most courses taught in Spanish\)](#) - Come live 9,000 feet above sea level in this high-altitude haven for all things fun: markets, mountains, and culture in the city, and beaches, jungles, and crater lakes all nearby. On our Semester in Ecuador you will study at Universidad San Francisco de Quito, a top-notch university, and improve your Spanish through both language and elective courses taught in Spanish. Some possible courses include International Justice Systems and Environmental Law.

FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS

Asia

China

- ❖ [Business & Culture in China](#) - 3 credits for BUSA 377 Takes place during Spring Break (9-11 days in March) Students will visit four major Chinese cities located in different areas of China (Beijing, Chengdu, Suzhou, and Shanghai) and experience many cultural activities and learn about the world's fastest growing economy.

Japan

- ❖ [Japan's History and Culture in Kyoto](#) - 3 credits for GS 320 or GS 350 GS 320 counts toward **Goal Area 5** Takes place during Summer (12-16 days in May) Students will learn about and experience all aspects of Japanese society - a blend of the ancient and the modern, by visiting Kyoto and its surrounding areas such as the metropolis of Osaka.

Europe

England and Scotland

- ❖ [Criminal Justice in England and Scotland](#) - 3 credits for SOC 480 Takes place during Summer (12-14 days in May) Students contrast and compare the criminal justice system in the UK with American criminal justice.

Poland

- ❖ [Economics of Poland](#) - 3 credits for BUSA 377 Takes place during Summer (14-16 days in May) Students will learn, through studying theories and through practical experiences, the concepts relative to international aspects of economics.

North America

Jamaica

- ❖ [Child Welfare, Health Systems, and Social Justice in Jamaica](#) - 3 credits for NURS 316 or SOCW 316 These courses count toward **Goal Area 8** Takes place during Winter Break (13-15 days in December/January) Students use a trans-cultural approach to learn about child welfare systems, with an emphasis on human rights, social justice, and health systems in Jamaica and US.
