

Men's Soccer Rules (unofficiated)



Team:

A team consists of 11 players (10 plus a goalie). A team must have 8 to start the game. If a team does not have 8, that team will forfeit the game.

Forfeit time:

5 minutes after scheduled game time.

Eligibility:

Please refer to eligibility form.

Must be a currently enrolled student or staff member.

Must have student I.d. with you. There will be periodic checks to ensure every team is using eligible players. If you do not have your student id and we do a roster check, you cannot play. No exceptions.

You may play for only 1 team.

Violation of any of the above will result in forfeiture of the game and/or season.

Rules:

- 1. A game will consist of two 20 minute halves with running time. There will be a 5 minute halftime break.
- 2. For the playoffs only, a tie after regulation will be followed by a 5 person shootout. Ties during the regular season will have no shootout and will end in a tie.
- 3. Start of the game: The kick-off is used at the beginning of each period and after each goal.
- 4. Each goal scored is 1 point.

5. No slide tackles!!

- 6. Everyone must respect the calls of the opponent.
- 7. Any player that is bleeding must leave the game immediately. They may only return once the bleeding is stopped, the wound is covered, and there is no blood on the clothing.
- 8. The scorekeeper is on site to keep track of time and the score. They are not a referee. All calls/disputes must be settled by the captains. The scorekeeper reserves the right to call the game a double forfeit if they feel it is becoming to rough or out of control.
