**NURS 606:** Nursing Information Management & Decision Making (3) (prerequisite to 1<sup>st</sup> Clinical Scholarship course)

**NURS 608:** Organizational & Systems Leadership (3) (prerequisite to 1<sup>st</sup> Clinical Scholarship course, N775)

**NURS 612/613:** Advanced Health Promotion of Families

**NURS 616:** Molecular/Genetics & Immune Mechanisms

**NURS 618:** Advanced Pathophysiology

**NURS 617:** Advanced Clinical Pharmacology (within 3 years of graduation in some states for credentialing)

**NURS 619:** Advanced Health Assessment (that includes diagnostic reasoning)

**Optional:** Nursing Research Review (modules) (not required), Other reviews (e.g., Theory, Stats) as needed (not required)

\*Clinical/practicum hour ratio is 1 credit hour to 60 clinical/practice hours

\*\*\*\*Prerequisite to admission: Graduation from a nationally accredited graduate program in nursing with a master's degree.
