NURS 606: Nursing Information Management & Decision Making (3) (prerequisite to 1st Clinical Scholarship course)

NURS 608: Organizational & Systems Leadership (3) (prerequisite to 1st Clinical Scholarship course)

****Prerequisite to the first AGCNS course includes evidence of completion of 1) advanced pathophysiology, 2) advanced health assessment, 3) advanced health promotion, and 4) advanced pharmacology (within the last three years required in some states for credentialing).
