- Proposal:
- Create a new student fee Sustainability Fee
- Provides better transparency to students
- Cost neutral to student
- Remove similar amount from student life fee
- \$0.42 per credit / \$5.04 per semester / \$10.08 per year
- Board max is \$20 per semester

Background:

- Students initially increased the student life fee to fund sustainability initiatives 2016
- Mn State Board of Trustees created new fee in June of 2023
