Asia

Japan

Osaka – Kansai Gaidai (Exchange)

Kansai Gaidai hosts about 700 international students a year and offers a wide variety of classes. Take classes like Japanese Popular Media and Culture, Japanese Influence on Western Art and Design, Manga Drawing, and Advanced Ceramic Techniques.

South Korea

Seoul - Chung Ang University (Exchange)

The College of Arts at Chung-Ang University is one of the best comprehensive colleges of arts in South Korea that has educated and produced a number of talented artists. Possible courses include Performance Film Creation, Design, Music, and Traditional Arts.

Czech Republic

Prague - AIFS Study Abroad in Prague, Charles University: Semester or Academic Year

Spend a semester or academic year in the picturesque capital city of Prague, Czech Republic, with AIFS! Choose from a variety of course options at Charles University, the largest and most prestigious university in the Czech Republic. Art classes at Charles University include Czech Modern and Contemporary Art and Architecture, Reciprocity of Thoughts: Czech Modern Art and Architecture and its Intellectual Context, and Edges of Photography.

Denmark

Copenhagen - DIS - Summer in Scandinavia

Experience this livable city first-hand and explore how architecture and design help put people first within functional and beautiful surroundings. Through seven weeks with DIS, you get to know the urban fabric by working on assignments that address real sites and interacting with the architecture and design community of Copenhagen. Take Art courses like Visual Journal, Graphic Design Foundations Studio, and Architecture Foundations Studio.

Germany

Berlin - AIFS Abroad in Berlin

Spend a semester or academic year in the dynamic and artistic city of Berlin, Germany, with AIFS! Study a variety of academic program options at Freie Universität Berlin (FU Berlin). Courses are taught mainly in English apart from a mandatory German language course and are scheduled Monday through Thursday. Some possible courses for Art students include History and Philosophy of Modern Art in Central Europe, Architecture in Berlin from the 19th Century to Today, and Art and Dictatorship. This program also has a summer option.

Hungary

Budapest - AIFS Abroad in Budapest

Spend a semester or academic year in the lively and culturally rich city of Budapest, Hungary, with AIFS! Choose from a variety of course options at Corvinus University, the leading higher education institute in Hungary. This campus is in Budapest's

commercial and political heart. Take Art courses like Budapest in the 20th Century: Historical Layers and Cultural Practices, Fields and Scenes: Arts, Culture, and Design, and Budapest Explorations of the Urban Space.

Italy

Florence - SAI Programs - Florence University of the Arts

Florence University of the Arts (FUA) presents a contemporary and thorough approach to a Liberal Arts education, along with an extensive curriculum in Studio Arts. With classes in Fashion Design and Merchandising, Digital and Studio Arts, and Art History, students will love Florence University.

Sorrento – Sant'Anna Institute – Direct Enroll

Sant'Anna Institute, located in the historical center of Sorrento, Italy overlooking the Bay of Naples, is a globally oriented campus that provides educational programs, through collaborative relationships with American and other foreign universities. Take classes like Special Topics: History of Art from Ancient Greece to Italian Renaissance, Special Topics: Drawing on Location, and Introduction to Digital Photography (only Summer).

Poland

Krakow - API Multidisciplinary Studies in Krakow

Through API you have the chance to go on excursions to see more of what Poland has to offer. Art courses offered include Media Art in Poland, Poland as a Work of Art, and A Survey of the Polish Art History: From Romanesque to Art Nouveau.

Edinburgh - CIS Abroad Semester in Edinburgh

Study at Edinburgh Napier University, a top-notch rigorous institution with three distinct campuses: Sighthill Campus, Merchiston Campus, and Craiglockhart Campus. Costa Rica

San Jose – CIS Abroad

Study abroad for a summer or semester in San José, Costa Rica to improve your Spanish and check out all that this amazing country has to offer. Study Spanish language exclusively, or study Spanish and another course from a variety of topics (mostly locally focused) in English or Spanish. <u>Europe</u>

Czech Republic and Hungary - Cities of Fairytales: Prague and Budapest

6 credits: ART 313 (3 credits) and ART 398 (3 credits). ART 313 counts toward Goal Areas 6B and 8. Takes place during Summer (18-22 days in May/June). Students complete intensive reading, lecture, studio art practice (design, photography, drawing and painting), group discussions, field trips, and art and design projects to learn and understand contemporary European society.

Germany – Berlin : Shifting the Paradigm

6 credits in ART 313 and ART 398. Takes place during Summer (14-17 days in May/June). Students will explore Berlin and its transformation through the lens of messaging that Germany used to shift the paradigm following the Nazi Regime with an incorporated critique of white supremacy and ethnic cleansing.

Italy - Taste of Italy

6 credits: ART 313 (3 credits) and ART 398/ART 299. ART 313 counts towards Goal Areas 6B and 8. Takes place during Summer (15-18 days in May). Students will learn about and focus on art, design, visual culture and lifestyle in contemporary Italy, against the backdrop of its rich ancient history.

<u>Oceania</u>

New Zealand - Made from Mountains: The Arts and Landscape of New Zealand

3 credits for ART 313. ART 313 counts for Goal Areas 6B and 8. Takes place during Summer (21-26 days in May/June). Students will study New Zealand art and film, reading New Zealand literature, and exploring how the physical landscape itself so profoundly shaped ideas of what it meant to be from these remote South Pacific islands.

Interning abroad is an exciting opportunity to gain valuable cross-cultural work experience, understand international perspectives in your field, and live in another country for a summer or semester. All internships are taken for credit, allowing financial aid to be used.
