Asia

Japan

Akita - Akita International University (Exchange)

The international campus culture of AIU seeks to selectively blend elements of main language from American universities with those of Japanese universities. Take English courses like Epic Origins of Literature, Introduction to Applied Linguistics, and Popular Culture in Language Learning & Teaching.

Tokyo - Sophia University (Exchange)

Sophia's reputation for excellence in undergraduate education, outstanding graduate programs, and a competitive research environment enables it to maintain its ranking as one of Japan's top private universities. English classes include Modern Japanese Fiction, Writing about Love: Past and Present, and Asian Texts: Legacy of the Past.

Taiwan

Taipei - Tamkang University (Exchange)

Tamkang University is a university of ideas, vision, and creativity. It sees the pursuit of excellence and ongoing innovation as characterizing, sustaining its fundamental management philosophy. English courses at TKU include Shakespeare, Introduction to English Linguistics, and Introduction to Western Literary Criticism.

Europe

Denmark

Copenhagen - DIS Literature

Filled with bike lanes, cobbled streets, and numerous cafes, Copenhagen is a great place to study abroad. DIS's programs are structured around academics, with a core course assigned for each field. The core course includes a week-long study tour in another country. With Literature, you will take the Core Course, A Sense of Place in European Literature, and electives you choose. English classes include Postcolonial Europe: Narratives, Nationalism, and Race; Travel Writing, Concept of Evil in Contemporary Culture, and Hans Christian Andersen and the Danish Golden Age.

Germany

Mainz - Koblenz Landau University - Exchange

This exchange is only open to English majors. Koblenz Landau is about an hour from Frankfurt and has seen its student size triple in the last 20 years. A variety of courses within the field of English are offered. Spring semester or academic year are options for this program.

<u>Italy</u>

Sorrento - Sant'Anna Institute - Direct Enroll

Sant'Anna Institute, located in the historical center of Sorrento, Italy overlooking the Bay of Naples, is a globally oriented campus. Sorrento is a quaint town with a cosmopolitan feel; a safe, walkable, and picturesque place with an international population - the ideal location to experience the heart of southern Italy. Take English classes like Creative Writing, World Literature, and European Literature and Gender.

Cuba

Havana - IFSA - Universidad de La Habana

Study at one of the most prestigious universities in Latin America and spend a long weekend living in an intentional community hours from Havana. Take English courses like General Linguistics, Dialectology and Sociolinguistics, and Cuban Literature.

Adelaide - IFSA - University of Adelaide

The University of Adelaide is located right in the heart of the city of Adelaide, which was recently called "Australia's best kept secret" thanks to its great weather, never-ending festivals, food and wine culture, and affordability. English courses include Prison Writing: Liberty and Language, European Stories, and All the Feelings: Affect and Contemporary Writing.

Gold Coast - IFSA - Griffith University

Study at one of the Asia-Pacific region's most progressive and dynamic universities with a wide range of studies. Take English Courses like Writing Across Cultures, Contemporary Australian Literature, and Gothic Afterlives.

New Zealand

Dunedin – API Full Curriculum at University of Otago in Dunedin

We invite you to study abroad in Dunedin, New Zealand at the University of Otago. The University of Otago is known as one of the top universities in New Zealand in terms of quality of learning, living, support, and student services. English courses include Magic and Treachery in Medieval Literature, A Topic in New Zealand Literature, and Creative Writing: Travel Narratives.

Europe

England - Live in Literature at Alnwick Castle, England

3 credits for ENG 120 or ENG 363. Takes place during Summer (16-20 days in May/June). ENG 120 counts toward Goal Area 6A. Students will study the connection between early English literature and the environment of Northeast England and the Alnwick Castle.

England – Escape to England: Poets, Priests, and Prisons

6 credits for ENG 211 and ENG 120 or ENG 363. Takes place during Summer (15 days in May/June). Students will travel around England to experience stories of castles, royals, religious leaders, medieval times, and more.

Italy - Dante in Italy

3 credits for ENG 221 or ENG 432. ENG 221 counts toward Goal Areas 6A and 8. Takes place during Summer (18-21 days in May). Students will explore the connection between the culture of Florence, Italy and Dante's Commedia (The Divine Comedy).

Interning abroad is an exciting opportunity to gain valuable cross-cultural work experience, understand international perspectives in your field, and live in another country for a summer or semester. All internships are taken for credit, allowing financial aid to be used.
