Global

Multiple Locations - [Semester at Sea](#)

Semester at Sea is a multiple country study abroad program open to students of all majors emphasizing comparative academic examination, hands-on field experiences, and meaningful engagement in the global community. A wide variety of coursework from 20-25 disciplines is integrated with field studies in up to a dozen countries, allowing for a study abroad experience that is truly global.

Japan

Akita – [Akita International University - Exchange](#)

Akita International University is a four-year liberal arts university located in the city of Akita, in northern Japan. It is a public university established in 2004 with a student population of around 900 students. English is the main language of instruction, and certain features of an American-style university curriculum are used. Take History classes like Global Encounters: A History of the Ancient and Medieval World, History of Modern Korea, and Modern History of Mongolia.

Tamkang University is a private university in New Taipei City, which is the most populous city in Taiwan and a major hub of East Asia. Take History classes like History of Taiwan, Introduction to Historiography, and Premodern China.

Germany – [Berlin : Shifting the Paradigm](#)

6 credits in ART 313 and ART 398. Takes place during Summer (14-17 days in May/June). Students will explore Berlin and its transformation through the lens of messaging that Germany used to shift the paradigm following the Nazi Regime with an incorporated critique of white supremacy and ethnic cleansing.

Japan – [Old Meets New: Timeless Japan](#)

3 credits: GS 320. GS 320 counts toward **Goal Area 5**. Takes place during Summer (13 days in May). Students will experience the modern way of life in Japan. They will analyze Japanese pop culture, its origins, and how it evolved since WWII.
