#### Japan

#### Akita - Akita International University (Exchange)

Pay WSU tuition at this exchange partner, where a variety of Political Science coursework in English is offered, like International Relations, Comparative Politics, and Forced Migration. Japanese language classes are also offered and highly encouraged.

#### **South Korea**

#### Seoul - Chung-Ang University (Exchange)

A private university of 30,000 students in Seoul, this exchange partner offers over 600 courses in English. Political science students can choose from courses like International Political Economy, Foreign Policy Analysis, History of American Foreign Relations, and Korean and Global Politics.

#### Taipei - Tamkang University (Exchange)

Pay WSU tuition and reasonable accommodation costs at Tamkang University, the oldest private university in Taiwan. Choose from Political Science classes such as History of Western Diplomacy, International Etiquette, Public Diplomacy, and Taiwan's Political Development.

#### Santiago - CIEE Open Campus Block Program in Santiago

## **FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS**

#### **Poland**

<u>Economics of Poland</u> - 3 credits for BUSA 377. Takes place during Summer (14-16 days in May). Students will learn, through studying theories and through practical experiences, the concepts relative to international aspects of economics.

#### Germany

<u>Berlin: Shifting the Paradigm</u> - 6 credits in ART 313 and ART 398. Takes place during Summer (14-17 days in May/June). Students will explore Berlin and its transformation through the lens of messaging that Germany used to shift the paradigm following the Nazi Regime with an incorporated critique of white supremacy and ethnic cleansing.

#### Spain

<u>Unity in Diversity</u> - 6 credits in GS 350. Takes place during Summer (21-25 days in May/June). Students will study different aspects of the culture of Spain today, with a special focus on its cultural and linguistic diversity.
