### South Korea

#### Seoul – Chung-Ang University (Exchange)

Chung Ang, located in Seoul is an exchange partner, meaning students pay WSU tuition and Chung Ang room and board. The university offers psychology courses such as Psychology of Language, Psychology of Adults and the Aged, and Psychological Statistics.

# Copenhagen – DIS Copenhagen - Psychology

This program focuses on psychological theory, research, and practice, with an emphasis on its application in a Danish and European context. Some program highlights are traveling with your classmates and DIS faculty on course-integrated study tours regionally and across Europe. Classes offered here include Cyberpsychology, European Clinical Psychology, and Positive Psychology. DIS also has a program focused on Child Development and Education in Scandinavia + Practicum.

### Westminster - CIS Abroad Semester in London - University of Westminster

During a Semester or Summer at Westminster, you can study in London, taking classes for your major or as electives at an internationally recognized institution while exploring this lively, diverse city. You can also intern at one of the city's many businesses and organizations, gaining practical experience and boosting your resume. Some courses that can be taken here include: Myth and Method in Psychology, Psychology of City Life, and Diverse and Alternative Approaches to Psychotherapy.

#### London - UW-Platteville Education Abroad at St Mary's University Twickenham, London

UW-Platteville Education Abroad has been helping students from across the United States study at St Mary's University Twickenham, London (St Mary's) since 1998. Since then, students from more than 130 universities nationwide have chosen to study abroad in London, England through UW-Platteville Education Abroad. Psychology courses available at this university include Psychopathology and Deviant Behavior, Deconstructing Psychology, and Political Psychology.

# Paris – <u>CIEE Open Campus Block Program in Paris</u>

#### Rome – SAI Programs – John Cabot University

Psychology courses include Clinical Psychology, Psychobiology, Stereotyping, and Prejudice and Discrimination.

# **Scotland**

# Aberdeen - University of Aberdeen (Direct Enroll)

The University of Aberdeen is a direct enroll option for students who wish to study a variety of coursework in Aberdeen, Scotland. There are many psychology courses available at this university, some of them including: Introductory Psychology I/II: Concepts and Theory, Introductory Psychology I/II: Methods and Applications, and Social Psychology.

# <u>Spain</u>

#### Madrid - University of Minnesota: Psychology & Research in Madrid

During the semester program, you can take up to 15 credits of Psychology along with other English-taught courses and Spanish language courses. Possible courses include Health Psychology, Cross-Cultural Psychology, Abnormal Psychology, and more.

# Stockholm – DIS Stockholm - Psychology

Build your semester by choosing a Core Course from 9 Academic Programs in Stockholm and select from upper-level courses– all taught in English. Or, in the summer, you can mix and match between either DIS location, Stockholm and Copenhagen, over five sessions – staying for just one session or adding together two to three sessions. Take Psychology courses like Forensic Psychology, Psychology of Emerging Adulthood, and Psychology Violence and Hate.

#### Gold Coast – IFSA - Griffith University

Spend a semester in the Sunshine State. Live and study by the beach at the Gold Coast campus in Surfer's Paradise. Or, if art is your thing, study at Queensland College of Art on the banks of the Brisbane River. Take Psychology courses like Personality Psychology, Career Psychology and Counseling, and Social and Cultural Psychology.

#### Lismore – Southern Cross University (Direct Enroll)

The Lismore campus, in its beautiful rainforest setting, hums with vitality and is a creative hub for the music, media and visual arts degrees for which it is renowned. Southern Cross University - Lismore is also home to state-of-the-art engineering and environmental science facilities. Take Psychology courses like Introduction to Psychological Investigation, Cross Cultural and Indigenous Issues in Psychology, and Social Psychology.

#### New Zealand

#### Dunedin – API Full Curriculum at University of Otago in Dunedin

The oldest university in the country, the University of Otago, is known as one of the top universities in New Zealand in terms of quality of learning, living, support, and student services. You can select from a broad array of courses in Business, Health Sciences, Humanities, and Natural Sciences. Take Psychology classes like Social and Applied Psychology, Behavior Analysis in Everyday Life, and Psychology in Legal Contexts.

# Austria – International Perspectives on Social Welfare in Austria

3 credits for SOCW 440. Takes place during Summer Break (about 14 days in May/June). Explore social justice and social welfare issues from an international perspective in one of the most beautiful countries in the world.

### Nepal - People and Culture of Nepal

3 credits for SOC 294. Takes place during Summer (15-19 days in May/June). Students will learn about the people living in the shadows of Himalayas and experience Nepali culture by directly interacting with local people and communities.

#### Germany - Berlin: Shifting the Paradigm

6 credits in ART 313 and ART 398. Takes place during Summer (14-17 days in May/June). Students will explore Berlin and its transformation through the lens of messaging that Germany used to shift the paradigm following the Nazi Regime with an incorporated critique of white supremacy and ethnic cleansing.
