SOCIOLOGY MAJORS

The following is a list of programs which offer Sociology courses. Sociology students have a choice to study abroad for a summer, semester or academic year. To determine the best time to go abroad, consult your academic advisor. Additionally, short term faculty-led programs may be offered with specific WSU Sociology coursework for 3-6 credits and vary term to term.

Asia

<u>Japa</u>n

Osaka - Kansai Gaidai (Exchange)

Kansai Gaidai is located outside Osaka, Japan. The campus hosts approximately 13,000 students, of which 700 are international students. Students may take a variety of courses offered in English ranging from art to business and a variety of general education courses. A Japanese language class is required of all international students. Take Sociology classes like Global and Transnational Sociology, Comparative Sociology, and Society, Health, and Wellbeing.

Tokyo – Sophia University (Exchange)

Sophia University's reputation for excellence in undergraduate education, outstanding graduate programs, and a competitive research environment enables it to maintain its ranking as one of Japan's top private universities. Courses in Liberal Arts and Science/Technology are taught in both English and Japanese. Take Sociology classes like Sociology of Sexuality and Gender, The Good Life: From Self to Society, and Introduction to Japanese Society.

Europe

Czech Republic

Prague - AIFS Study Abroad in Prague, Charles University: Semester or Academic Year

Spend a semester or academic year in the city of Prague, Czech Republic with AIFS at Charles University. This program is designed for students wishing to gain insight into the history, culture, and development of Eastern and Central Europe by taking courses across a range of subject fields. Take Sociology classes like Sociology of Food, Czech Republic: An Urban Perspective, and Landscape Sociology: Understanding of Czech and European Landscapes – Department.

Denmark

Copenhagen - CIEE Open Campus Block Program in Copenhagen

Experience Copenhagen your way by customizing your study abroad experience through the Open Campus program. Study in Scandinavia with an English-language program designed for students at US universities. Take one, two, or three six-week blocks. No matter what you choose, you'll get a chance to fully experience a city full of history, culture, and innovation. Take Sociology courses like Gender and Sexuality, Race and Ethnicity, and The Study of Scandinavian Happiness.

England

London – CIS Abroad Semester in London – University of Westminster

On our University of Westminster program, take classes right in the heart of London at an internationally recognized institution. Germany

Dublin - CIS Abroad Semester in Dublin - Dublin City University

Nepal - People and Culture of Nepal

3 credits for SOC 294. Takes place during Summer (15-19 days in May/June). Students will learn about the people living in the shadows of Himalayas and experience Nepali culture by directly interacting with local people and communities.

England - Escape to England: Poets, Priests, and Prisons

6 credits for ENG 211 and ENG 120 or ENG 363. Takes place during Sumer (15 days in May/June). Students will travel around England to experience stories of castles, royals, religious leaders, medieval times, and more.

Japan – Old Meets New: Timeless Japan

3 credits: GS 320. GS 320 counts toward **Goal Area 5**. Takes place during Summer (13 days in May). Students will experience the modern way of life in Japan. They will analyze Japanese pop culture, its origins, and how it evolved since WWII.
