FIRE

EVACUATE BUILDING

- Give directions to meet at designated evacuation location
- Shut off lights and close doors
- Use stairs, not elevators
- Remain low if encountering smoke
- Pull fire alarm, if possible
- Use fire extinguisher, if necessary
- Call 911



MOVE TO A SAFE LOCATION

- Give directions to meet at designated shelter area
- Shut off lights and close doors/windows
- Go to shelter area, basement, interior hallway or restroom on the lowest floor and stay away from windows
- Remain in shelter until it's safe



CONTACT EMERGENCY SERVICES

- Call 911
- State who, what, where, when, why and how the situation occurred
 - Medical Emergency
 - Suspicious package
 - o Suspicious activity
 - Suspicious person
 - o Bomb threat
- If bomb threat, turn off electronics
- If medical situation, locate nearest Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and follow instructions

Alert

• You become aware of a threat (emergency alert, gunshot, etc)

A.L.I.C.E

VIOLENT

INCIDENT

Lockdown

- If evacuation is not a safe option
- Barricade entry points
- Close blinds turn lights off
- Spread out, do not huddle together
- Prepare for counter if needed

Inform

- Call 911 if safe to do so
- Communicate real time information on threat location
- Use clear, direct language

Counter

- Use as a last resort
- Create noise, movement, distance and distraction to reduce shooter's accuracy
- Counter is NOT fighting
- Swarm suspect with others if possible

Evacuate

- When safe to do so, remove yourself from the danger zone
- Look for alternate evacuation points (windows, second doorway, stairwells)
