### Winona State Athletic Fee History\*

- 2022-23 academic year and prior: Minn State athletic fee maximum was \$55 per semester.
  - Winona State at \$54.96 per semester for 2019-20 through 2022-23 academic years
- 2023-24 academic year: Minn State athletic fee maximum was increased to \$75 per semester
  - Winona State at \$56.04 per semester for 2023-24
  - Referendum in Spring 2024 resulted in increase of 10.06% to \$61.68 per semester



### Minnesota State University System Comparison

All four-year schools (sponsoring athletics) in the Minn State System are in various stages of working up to the new max.

Bemidji State University: \$75 per semester

Southwest Minnesota State University: \$75 per semester


Minnesota State University Moorhead: \$75 per semester

St. Cloud State University: \$73.89 per semester\*

Minnesota State University: \$66.96 per semester

#### Winona State University: \$61.68 per semester

\*St Cloud State is banded at 9 credits instead of 12
