 - Resume
 - Personal Statement (no more than 2 pages in length) that includes the following information:
 - Desire for pursuing athletic training as a career
 - Previous experience with athletic training
 - Reason for choosing Winona State University
 - One characteristic about yourself that makes you stand out from the other WSU MSAT program applicants
 - Professional goals and how the WSU MSAT program will help you achieve those goals
 - Transcripts from all College/University attended
 - Two Letters of Recommendation
 - TOEFL Score (for International Students only)
