BUED 610 – Training & Leadership Relations (3 CR)

Leadership topics will be addressed including effective leadership strategies, risk taking, engaging and strengthening others, clarifying values, and celebrating success. Related communication topics will also be addressed including fostering collaboration, strategic and organizational communication, envisioning and communicating goals. *ATD Competencies: Change/Leadership/Management Development*

BUED 640 – Training Theory & Application (3 CR)

This course will provide an overview of training theory and application methods used to develop effective training programs. Key phases of the training and development process will be addressed including analysis, design, implementation, and evaluation. Related topics will include research-based training principles, current trends, and effective use of technology in training. *ATD Competencies: Instructional Design/Training Delivery/Learning Technologies*

BUED 641 – Training Design & Workplace Wellness (3 CR)

This course will focus on effective training methods in various settings with emphasis on the positive impact leaders can have on such environments. A holistic approach will be utilized addressing instructional design and leadership strategies that support individuals' physical, mental, and social well-being. *ATD Competencies: Instructional Design & Planning/Managing Learning Programs/Leadership*

BUED 670 - Seminar in Training and Education (3 CR)

Specific subject matter is arranged by the BUED faculty. May be repeated when offered with different subject matter content and title. Offered when demand warrants. *ATD Competencies: Career-focused, customized learning experience so any or all competencies could be addressed.*
