

ATI Testing Setup Instructions for a Mac Laptop

- We recommend if you are experiencing any issues (screen issues, malware, battery, etc.) with your laptop before the test, visit WSU Tech Support in Somsen 207.
- You will need the ATI username and password you set up when you registered for the test.
- **Plan to shut down your computer completely and restart just before taking the test. Also close out of all open applications and programs. We don't want anything to interrupt your testing session.**
 - Press these three keys together: Option, Command, and Esc. Or choose Force Quit from the Apple menu in the upper-left corner of your screen.
 - Then select the app in the Force Quit window and select Force Quit on all programs.
 - You should only have Chrome and the Finder open.
- **If you use Messages on your Mac, you will want to turn on do not disturb temporarily. (This will temporarily turn off your text messages notifications.)**
 - Go to the control center, located on the top-right corner of your screen next to the date and time. (which looks like a series of stacked toggle switches)
 - Select Focus, this will turn on do not disturb.
- You will need to make sure that your Mac OS is 15 or higher (Tahoe and Sequoia are suitable.) **To check your Mac OS, go to the apple logo on the top left of your home screen page, then Select "About This Mac." If you have the latest update, you will be on macOS Sequoia version 15.7 or macOS Tahoe version 26.0.0.**
- We recommend using Google Chrome as your browser for TEAS. If you don't already have Google Chrome, (It is by default pre-installed on WSU laptops) you can download Google Chrome [here](#). After you have finished downloading Google Chrome simply follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
 - **Check the current version of Google Chrome on a Mac:**
 - Open Google Chrome and select on **Google Chrome** on the menu bar (located next to the Apple Icon in the upper-left corner) and select **About Google Chrome**.
 - This will show the version of Chrome and check for updates.
 - The current version 140.0.7339.186 (9/22/25) but any version starting from 119 or later will work.
 - If Chrome needs to update, select Relaunch to apply it.
- You **must** enable cookies, Javascript and allow pop-up and redirects from www.atitesting.com in your browser to complete the test.
 - Open Google Chrome and select on **Google Chrome** on the menu bar (located next to the Apple Icon in the upper-left corner) and select the **Settings**.
 - Choose the **Privacy and Security** settings tab on the left.
 - Select **Site Settings** category and scroll down to these settings under the Content section:
 - Third-party cookies
 - Go down to **Sites allowed to use third-party cookies** and select **Add**.
 - Enter the testing address (www.atitesting.com) and select **Add**.
 - Arrow back to Site Settings. Select **JavaScript**
 - Ensure "Sites can use JavaScript" radio button is on. (If the circle to the left is filled in or blue, this indicates it is on.)
 - Arrow back to Site Settings. Select **Pop-Ups and redirects**.
 - Select "Add" to the right of the "Allowed to send pop-ups and use redirects." Enter the testing address (www.atitesting.com) and select **Add**.
