Winona State University is open for inter/national fraternity expansion and is welcoming letters of interest. We believe the addition of one or two new fraternities to our community over the next two years would enrich the overall fraternity and sorority experience. Winona State University is a public institution within the Minnesota State System. We are a community of learners improving our world. Located in the southeastern corner of MN we are nestled in the driftless region along the Mississippi. We are home to over 6,000 total students with 30.5% of those being male. Our Fall 2025 new entering freshman class is entering with a 11.7% enrollment increase. Student success is a strong initiative for us, and we continue to boast the #1 student success rate in the Minnesota State System with 76.8% of our students retaining fall to fall. Student engagement remains high with over 130 registered student organizations boasting 750 unique leadership positions.

Currently our community is home to three recognized sororities, Alpha Sigma Tau, Delta Phi Epsilon, and Sigma Sigma Sigma, and one recognized fraternity, Sigma Tau Gamma. There is staff and administration support for community growth, and we believe with our enrollment growth, now is a perfect time to add to our community.

Our community has not grown in over 8 years, and we believe that expanding our fraternity and sorority community will bring more interest, excitement, and positive growth. Our goal is to add one to two chapters over the next two years with one starting as early as Fall 2026.
